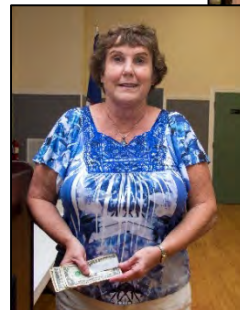


This month I want to give special thanks to Dora Holman and Nell Poates for picking up and bringing the chicken each month for our luncheon. They also
